

Attractions

Art gallery openings, concerts, studio artists, specialist antiques shops, gift shops, bookshops and world renowned crafted furniture, sculpture and design giftware – these vibrant and diverse village attractions make this country village a much talked about place to visit

Galleries and Craft

2016 marks 33 years for **Bungendore Wood Works Gallery (3)**, now a cultural landmark for the region. The National Tourism Award winning Gallery draws visitors from all states and overseas for its outstanding exhibition of wood work gifts, sculpture, fine furniture and visual arts by leading Australian designer/makers and artists.

Bungendore Fine Art (6) opened in 2005. This Gallery is owned and operated by eight artists from the surrounding region, they are providing quality art for all tastes and budgets. The Gallery displays around 150 paintings ranging from large works to miniatures. Open seven days a week, with monthly exhibitions featuring guest artists, some new faces, some well-known.

Paul Kowalski Photography Gallery (8) showcases Paul's stunning and award winning fine art landscape photography from around Australia. Offering a diverse collection of framed photographic prints and gifts, the gallery is the perfect setting to view Paul's immaculate photographic work that is all captured on film. Also on offer are photographic workshops and tours. Open Thursday to Monday, be immersed in the Australian landscape.

The **Gumnut Gallery and Art to Wear on Malbon (10)** is a treasure trove of Lampwork glass beads, fairies, teddy bears, hats, fashion accessories, jewellery and children's wear. Beaded, embroidered, hand dyed silk and felted garments including reconstructed fashion designs by local studio artists Robyne and Renée d'Argeavel. Works by regional artisans, a full range of quality cane baskets and selected home-wares. Open Friday to Monday 10-4, Tuesday to Thursday by appointment.

At **Bungendore Village Leather (5)** you will find the country's finest collection of leather-craft by Australian and overseas craftsmen. Feel, smell and appreciate a natural product second to none.

X Gallery (18) situated in a beautifully restored barber's shop, has an emphasis on high quality art and objects by regional artists. Featuring contemporary jewellery by resident silversmith Xanthe Gay and glass, ceramics and fine art as well as world-renowned products by Fink & Co Design.

Suki & Hugh Gallery (18) is a purpose built gallery exhibiting the work of an exciting contemporary artist every six weeks. The gallery shop offers high quality and unique hand made objects.

A quintessential art and craft shop, **Bungendore Art Connection (20)** is run by resident artists, Tania and Vivien Laycock, always happy to chat about painting, kiln work, spinning, knitting and woodcraft. Bungendore souvenirs available, and for the art enthusiast, an excellent Papua New Guinea art collection is on permanent display.

Antiques

Village Antiques (11) has half an acre of antiques and collectables. Chairs, tables, cabinets, sideboards, rustic and restored items, decorative and statement objects, outdoor ornamental and architectural pieces.

Retro and Record Emporium (9) is a unique retro store specialising in vinyl records, second hand books, pottery, glassware, art, sci-fi collectables, vintage toys, furniture

Trading since 1992 **Deniston Cottage Antiques (24)** is set in an 1878 stone cottage and sells country and Colonial Cedar and pine furniture, rustic and primitive pieces, old lamps and prints. At 16 Molonglo Street, open weekends and holidays 11-4pm and by appointment.

Annie's Collectables (27) 25km from Bungendore at 39 Cooper Road, Wamboin has an extensive range of affordable antiques and collectables including Carlton Ware, uranium glass, Shelley, Wedgwood, Doulton, crystal, silver, glass, vintage clothing and jewellery. Open weekends and public holidays 10.30-4.30 and by appointment at other times.

Gift Shops

A fine art gallery ambience, air-conditioned summer comfort, warm in winter, alfresco dining – it all makes for a most stylish dining experience. The Wintergarden (4) at the Carrington Inn offers 4 distinctive heritage-dining venues for travelers and locals. The Empire Salons provide fine dining in a lovely Victorian parlor while the Tom Wills Tavern & Tapas Courtyard serves friendly share-plate meals with a variety of beverages.
